

SUMMARY OF THE CODE OF CONDUCT FOR INTER COUNTY TOURNAMENT

1. No bowler may smoke or consume alcohol at any time during the tournaments, even if legally permitted to do so.
2. Bowlers will comply with all legal instructions from the Officials, and will conform strictly with any curfews imposed.
3. Any bowler who is in a condition considered unfit to bowl will be withdrawn.
4. Any bowler who is found to be in possession of any offensive weapon or material will be withdrawn.
5. Bowlers will attend any E.C.T.A. arranged meals and must stay with their team.
6. Bowlers must be at the places advised, at the times specified, complete with all necessary equipments and sundries that they need.
7. Bowlers will dress, behave and speak modestly. Dress will be 'smart casual'. Immoderate language and rudeness are unacceptable
8. Essex shirts are only to be worn whilst actually representing Essex.

PLEASE NOTE THAT IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PARENTS/GUARDIAN OF EACH PLAYER TO ARRANGE OVERNIGHT ACCOMMODATION AND TRANSPORT TO THE BOWL(S) FOR THE INTER-COUNTY TOURNAMENTS

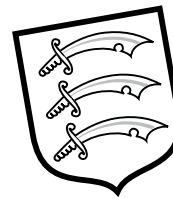

1. The Roll-off is sanctioned by the B.T.B.A. and their General and Tournament Rules together with any such additional Rules as may be required by the appropriate Inter County Regulations will apply together with the following rules:
2. Participants MUST be members of the B.T.B.A., and should be eligible to hold a British Passport, or must have lived continuously in the U.K. for 5 years. Competitors must have been born in Essex or have resided therein for at least one year (HM Forces – six months). All individual Application for Change of Registration must be lodged for one year before becoming effective. IF IN DOUBT – PLEASE ASK!
3. Participants must be under the relevant age as at the 31st August 2011.
4. Six games will be bowled at each centre. Bowlers will change lane as directed after each game. Bowling will be in teams (maximum of 5's) as determined by number of bowlers entering each squad.
5. Squadding will be on a first come, first served basis with a limited number of places.
6. The top scratch scorers in each division shall be selected to play at least two (2) games in the Inter County Tournaments. The remaining places in the County Squads will be selected from these roll-offs for both boys and girls. The teams will be selected from the County Squads. Essex teams shall be selected in strict accordance with the Inter County Rules currently applicable, all qualifiers must have completed the eligibility section. Members of a National Squad will NOT be seeded into the Essex squad.
7. Each squad member must sign a code of conduct, a summary of which is on this entry form.
8. Failure to produce a current B.T.B.A. Membership card will incur a fine of £25.00.
9. Registration will be 30 minutes prior to squad times; latecomers will commence bowling at the frame in progress when they are actually ready to bowl.
10. No denim or 'denim look' clothing; no shorts of any type; shirts must have collars and sleeves, smart track suit bottoms are acceptable, but not shell suits/bottoms; you may not smoke nor drink alcohol, even if legally permitted to do. Eating is allowed out of the playing area as long as play is not interrupted.
11. Only tournament officials and competitors will be allowed in the players area during the tournament. In accordance with B.T.B.A. Rule 333. Coaches and instructors are required to display their licence at all times and also must be dressed and act in accordance with their position.
12. A provisional ball shall be rolled in the case of a dispute relating to pinfall which cannot be resolved on the spot.
13. All protests must be made verbally at the time of the occurrence to the Tournament Manager, and confirmed in writing within 72 hours.
14. The decisions of the Tournament Committee, Mary Ellis (Tournament Manager), Graham Ellis and Leeroy Copping, will be final in all matters; subject to an individuals right of appeal to the B.T.B.A.
15. Entry fees will be a total of **£26.50**, including a £1.00 per junior donation to the Junior International Fund. There is no contribution to a prize fund. No refunds will be made after acceptance. The entry fee MUST accompany the entry.
