**NAYBC JUNIOR TEAM ENGLAND RANKING EVENT
B.T.B.A. SANCTIONED 31/0025**

ELIGIBILITY

This tournament is open to all juniors who are members of the BTBA and will be under the age of 19 as at 31st August at the end of the bowling year. As per the JTE ranking criteria, bowlers will also need to be registered for the JTE ranking tour. Ranking points are only gained by current members at the time of the event. 'Remember it is the responsibility of each bowler to ensure they are BTBA members'.

DIVISIONS

The tournament is open to ALL JUNIOR BOWLERS who hold a JTE Tour card and will be split into 2 divisions: Male and Female.

RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE TOURNAMENT

1. This is a Junior Team England event and the general playing and tournament rules of the BTBA will govern this tournament together with the following special rules and regulations. Entry to the tournament is subject to the acceptance of the covering rules.
2. Entry fees must accompany the entry form, which must reach the Tournament Manager by 12pm midday on Friday 5th February 2010.
3. Squadding will be in order of entry receipt, on a first come – first served basis, so if travelling a long distance book early.
4. Once the squadding is issued, entry fees are non refundable if players are withdrawn without replacement.
5. The Tournament Committee will consist of: Leeroy Copping as 'Tournament Manager', Mary Ellis and Andy Thurston. The committee reserves the right to reject, re-rate or accept any entry and their decision on all matters shall be final subject to appeal to the BTBA.
6. A provisional ball must be rolled if a dispute relating to pinfall cannot be resolved immediately. Any protest must be lodged with the Tournament Committee within 30 minutes of the infraction occurring and confirmed in writing prior to the trophy presentation. No protests relating to prior scores will be accepted once the cut or final has commenced.
7. Only competitors and one licensed Instructor/Coach per competitor will be allowed in the player's area during the game. With reference to coaching /instruction please refer to BTBA Rule 333 for details. Instructors MUST display their licences at all times when involved in coaching/instructing competitors, and are also to be dressed in accordance with their position.
8. No competitor will be allowed to smoke or consume alcohol anywhere in the centre during the tournament. Bad language, improper gestures, the abuse of bowling equipment or machinery is forbidden. Any breach of this rule will result in the individual being disqualified from the tournament. Any disqualification may result in the loss of scores and awards. Any junior so disqualified will be reported to the BTBA for consideration of disciplinary proceedings.
9. Competitors, who in the opinion of the Tournament Committee are not dressed in correct bowling attire in the player's area, will not be permitted to bowl. Sponsors names (excluding alcohol or tobacco products) are permissible. Shorts or denim clothing of any description will not be permitted, however SKORTS (skirt/shorts) will be allowed for female competitors. YBC Officials are also expected to abide by above rules. The wearing of hats during play is not allowed unless at the Tournament Committees discretion. Mobile phones and their use in the players area is not allowed – they must be switched off during play.
10. Registration will be 30 minutes prior to each squad. Tardy players will commence at the frame in progress as directed by the Tournament Committee.
11. All entrants must be in possession of a current BTBA membership card, or association equivalent, non-production of this card will result in a £5 fine.
12. Tie Rules: In the situation of a tie for any position, the highest last game will be used to determine the higher position. In the situation where there is still a tie, then the penultimate games score will be used. Should there still be a tie, then the highest of all games will be taken. If there is a tie after the qualifying round, highest single game will progress, if still tied then a one frame roll off will determine who progresses.
13. Bowlers must wear bowling attire at the presentation.

SPECIAL NOTES

- A. Squad times and dates will be given in advance to allow for accommodation reservations and travel arrangements. Please telephone the Tournament Manager for confirmation of this point before making any booking arrangements.
- B. The Tournament Manager will make all squad and lane allocations.
- C. Presentations will be made at the conclusion of the last squad (approx. 6.45pm Sunday 28th February 2010). All competitors that have finished First to Third in each event are expected to be present to receive their awards wearing correct bowling attire.
- D. Only food and drink purchased in the centre may be consumed in the centre.
- E. The bowling centre management and its staff will not be held responsible for any injuries, damage, loss of equipment or loss of belongings during the tournament.

FORMAT

Qualifying Rounds: All competitors will play 6 games within their division, moving lanes as directed after each game. There will then be a cut to the top 48 players in each division.

Seeding will be determined on the finishing position in the qualifying round.

The top 16 players in each division will receive a bye in the next round.

Pinfall will be zeroed after each round.

During the Matchplay Rounds the winner of each match will progress.

Matchplay Round 1: Players seeded 17 to 48 will play 2 games, 17 playing 48, 18 playing 47, etc.

Matchplay Round 2: The winners of round 1 will play 2 games seeded against the 16 byes from the qualifying round. (Winners of match 17v48 will play seed 16; winners of match 18v47 will play seed 15, etc.)

Matchplay Round 3: The winners of round 2 will then enter into a 2 game knockout. All matches will be ordered so that the top seeds (if they win) will not meet each other until the latest possible round.

Team England ranking points will be based on the finishing positions in the tournament.

First place will receive 100 points down to 1 point for 100th place. (Please note only those juniors who are members of the BTBA and hold current JTE Cards will be eligible for points awards).

Any ties for positions with regard to ranking points will be decided on total pinfall.

For bowlers in their last year who cannot qualify for Junior Team England, points will count towards qualification for the Junior UK Championships.
